### **Allotment Tenants Privacy Notice**

When you sign and return your Allotment Tenancy Agreement

The information you provide (personal information such as name, address, email address, phone number) will be processed and stored so that it is possible to contact you and respond to your correspondence, provide information, send invoices and receipts relating to your allotment tenancy. Your personal information will be not shared or provided to any other third party.

### **The Councils Right to Process Information**

The General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") will take effect in the UK from 25 May 2018. It replaces the existing law on data protection (the Data Protection Act 1998) and gives individuals more rights and protection regarding how their personal data is used by councils. Ironville Parish Council must comply with the following requirements, just like any other organisation.

- Processing is with consent of the data subject
- Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation
- Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract with the data subject or to take steps to enter into a contract

### **Information Security**

Ironville Parish Council cares to ensure the security of personal data. We make sure that your information is protected from unauthorised access, loss, manipulation, falsification, destruction or unauthorised disclosure. This is done through appropriate technical measures and relevant policies.

We will only keep your data for the purpose it was collected for and only for as long as is necessary. After which it will be deleted.

## **Your Rights**

### **Access to Information**

### **Information Correction**

### **Rights Related to Automated Decision Making and Profiling**

Ironville Council does not use automated decision making or profiling of personal data.

### **To Sum Up**

In accordance with the law, we only collect a limited amount of information about you that is necessary for correspondence, information and service provision. We do not use profiling, we do not sell or pass your data to third parties. We do not use your data for purposes other than those specified. We make sure your data is stored securely. We delete all information deemed to be no longer necessary. We constantly review our Privacy Policies to keep it up to date in protecting your data.
